ADDITIONAL NOTE FOR ANNUAL SUMMARY

At Bustamente Federal Park, near Sabinas Hidalgo, Nuevo Leon, Mexico, 23 Oct., 1966, E.E. Remington observed very large migrations of Danaus plexippus (flying SW, going thru all day) and Libytheana bachmanii (directionality not obvious). At night, D. plexippus roosting by the hundreds in the trees and several came around Coleman lanterns. Also numerous there: Kricognia lyside, Phoebis spp., Eurema spp., Zerene cesonia, Danaus gilippus Adelpha bredowii, Urbanus sp. --C. L. Remington.
