with a curved edge. the back ~~is~~ straight  
and about  $\frac{1}{2}$  in thick, while the  
edge is very thin. There is a hole  
in one end of it. I supposed to sling it

to carry. The stone is not like any  
found about here.

whether they are worth sending to you  
If you think they are I will send  
them

I should have said before the knife  
was found in the western part of  
this place I think.
