Your favor of

18th inst came duly to hand & the same day box containing minerals, 4 vols Palaeontology of N. Y., & the two college reports - I am extremely well pleased with both books & minerals. I scarcely know which most though of course books are most valuable. The latter are in much better condition than expected them - in fact could not be in better order. Prof Harper called for his package & was very much pleased with it. We have spent our leisure time for last 8 weeks in examining banks of Ohio River for 15 miles above & same distance below Cincinnati & know all the points in that distance where

"relics" are to be found

Have collected considerable number
both of "flint" & "stone" but nothing extra-
ordinary

The only (to us) rare
material was two pieces of implements
made of Barite the first have seen
of that material - found by my partner
Dr. Hill - He find pieces of Pottery
but no whole pots - The pieces
so far found with one exception
are made of clay shells & baked

The exception was one piece of a steatite
pot which must have been cut out
of solid ~~rock~~ stone the nearest quarry
of which is said to be across in North
Carolina - We hope to have pleasure of
seeing you this spring or summer &
to show you some of the camping grounds
& remains of arrow head factories &c.
