We credited your a/c. as enclosed Statement and also with \$5⁵⁰ more interest on Treasury \$20⁰⁰ Note.

You charged us the Note with A 7. interest but we got in the first Bank A 12⁵⁰ "

With Wagon we send also empty Sacks for Corn & Woolpacks, but you have to look out that the agent returns Sacks if not you have to charge him 25 cents for each Sack. We do not think it is necessary to tell Don Elizeo anything about the Note but do as you best.

The 2 Bonds of Mr. Baldwin we send to the Capt's Office at Santa Fe as requested

but Mr Black the Agent refuses to send them
on, unless security is given here that the
charges on same would be paid.

Mr Black said he had some trouble
collecting the charges on some boxes sent
by some party before some time ago.

You will tell Mr Baldvine about it
and the boxes are at his disposal at
the Express office and not forwarded
