My dear Sir,

I have recently had placed in my hands for sale a collection of Indian Antiquities which perhaps you might like to acquire for the Peabody Museum at New Haven.

There are about 70 stone Chisels and gouges from the Upper Ottawa, 60 arrow & spear heads - one of copper - 9 stone & Clay pipes, fragments of pottery, fragments of pottery, & a beautiful vase which is entire and nearly a foot in diameter. It was taken from an Indian grave near Ottawa. There is also a curious knife for chopping meat, or scraping skins perhaps, & a number of other articles whose uses I do not know.

I think the collection could be bought for \$200.00, will you kindly let me know whether you would like to obtain it?
