I am ordered to command an Expedition of 5 Co's Cavalry and 2 of Infantry into the Big Horn Country with base of supplies at Rawlins W.T. and have starting Camp some where north of the Sweet-Water to return with Cold weather

If you want any more bones would be glad to have you with us although as far as Indians are concerned we are on the offensive and could not perhaps accommodate you as much in time and transportation as we did before.
