My Sir,

Your letter of the 17th rec'd today. There are several Indians buried near the Post, and I don't think the Comdg Officer will allow them disturbed, as every while there are Indians down here from the agency, & if they should find the place had been disturbed in any way it might cause trouble.

I know where there are two bodies buried about three or four miles from Post, & if I can get an

me, will try to get one for
you, that is unless the
County Co. interferes in the
matter which I think will
not,

For sure that it will take
some time to Macrae, Clean,
& flesh so that it will be
all right for shipment, but
will do the best thing possible
for you in the matter,
