According to Dr Cope's determination some of the specimens I sent him last as far as I can recollect belong to the species of *Elephas columbi*, and *Cimoliasaurus* sp. (crista). You can get some teeth and skulls belonging to these species found in the same bed from Messrs Frickerson & Davis, Bryant Brazos County Texas.
