And I, Albert Smith do hereby constitute and appoint the
said Jas. A. Gunn and ~~his~~ ^{their} assigns to be my attorney
irrevocable in the premises, to do and perform all acts, matters, and things touching the
premises, in the like manner to all intents and purposes as I could if personally present.
