My dear sir:-

Your inquiry regarding the question as to my having found a bone in a sand stone quarry, half a mile north of Greenfield, Mass., was correct. I loaned the stone in which the bone was imbedded to Mr. Stoughton, who has either lost it or given it away to some other party.

I remember distinctly the general appearance of the bone. It apparently was the end or joint of the bone, and was, as I remember, an inch and a quarter to an inch and a half square, or nearly square.

I am unable now to give you any further details, but I distinctly remember it had the appearance of a bone, and was firmly imbedded in the stone.
